Please note: entries will not be accepted from J14 competitors or younger in any event.

Please be sure that your competitors are capable of steering safely and performing competitively over the course. Winners' medals will be awarded for all events with three or more entries and, for J15 events, second and third place medals will also be awarded.

With the new Athlete Ranking system now being formed it is important that all substitutions are completed through the BROE system. All substitutions must be made online up and can be amended up to the start of the race, please ensure your crews are correct, as this will influence your athletes' individual ranking for future events!
