### **Dennis King Cup**

Dennis King was a pupil at the School and School Captain in 1939-40. He was killed while *en route* to serve in the Sudan, when the troop-ship SS Ceramic was sunk by enemy action in December 1942. The cup was presented to the School in his memory by his parents, Mr and Mrs G R King.

The Dennis King Cup is awarded to a Sixth Former who has devoted much time and effort to helping the School with loyalty, modesty and efficiency.

This year the Dennis King Cup and Prize for unselfish service to the School is awarded to Fergus Briston.

# **Howes Cup** (Fitzwygram proxime accessit)

The Howes Cup was presented to the School in 1939 by T G Howes (OH 1930-37). It is awarded each year to the runner-up for the Fitzwygram Prize (q.v.), in recognition of his outstanding contribution to the School.

This year the Howes Cup and Prize is awarded to Jonah Blake, Fergus Briston, Finlo Cowley, Jai Saha, Abhinand Sundaram

## Fitzwygram Cup

The Revd Fitzroy John Fitzwygram was a Governor of the School, which originally adjoined the Parish Church of St Mary in Hampton. He was appointed the first vicar of the new parish of St James, Hampton Hill, established in 1863, where he worked to improve the prospects of the poor and founded several schools.

The Fitzwygram Prize is the most prestigious award at Hampton School. It is presented to the most outstanding Upper Sixth Former (normally but not necessarily the outgoing School Captain) for his contribution to the School.

This year the Fitzwygram Cup and Prize is awarded to Sam Evans.
